The Quarter Note Club (QNC) was established in 1999 as a parent organization to support the development of the Garnet Valley High School Band programs. The Club provides assistance in the following ways:

- Provides essential adult support for various activities, including chaperones at football games and competitions, assistance with equipment and uniforms, and organizing band camp and other special events.
- Organizes fund-raising activities in which students are able to earn money to help defray costs of band dues, field trips and special events.
- Provides financial assistance to the band toward the purchase of instruments, equipment and other special purchases.
- Sponsors the GVHS Jazz Fest wherein jazz musicians from neighboring middle and high schools play and compete in an adjudicated event.
- Sponsors annual scholarships for graduating seniors.
- Promotes student band leadership by providing monetary support for band students who attend approved leadership training or drum major camps.

UNIFORMS

Show T-Shirts

Each student will be given a T-shirt for the current year's show, free of charge (the "Garnet Show Shirt"). The Garnet Show Shirt is part of both the Formal Uniform and Casual Uniform as noted below. Additional T-shirts will be available for sale to family and friends for \$15 each, subject to availability.

Formal Uniform

Our Formal Band uniform consists of black bib pants, a garnet jacket and a black hat with a plume. These uniforms are property of the school and are assigned to band members for use during the marching band season. The <u>current</u> Garnet Show Shirt <u>must</u> be worn under the black bib at every performance. In colder weather, a thermal layer of <u>black</u> Under Armor or similar insulating tech clothing is recommended for wear <u>under</u> the Garnet Show Shirt.

Band uniforms will be fitted and distributed throughout the week of band camp. Please make sure that you see the uniform committee. Remember, they are volunteering their time to help you look your best! Please show them respect.

It is your responsibility to keep your uniform clean and odor free. If your uniform becomes unacceptable during the marching band season you are responsible for having it cleaned at your own expense. Garnet Valley uses Concord Cleaners located in Concordville Town Center (next to the Acme). The uniform must stay at school unless it needs to be signed out for cleaning.

Shoes should <u>only</u> be placed in the back shoe pocket of the students' uniform bag, never in the main compartment with the uniform!!

Return of uniforms is considered a student obligation for graduation and/or receiving their report card.

Shoes

All Band and Color Guard members must purchase the appropriate uniform shoes at their own expense (see the attached Band Shoes form or Color Guard Shoes form for details). Returning students may use their old uniform shoes unless they need a different size or if the shoes are damaged so as to no longer be presentable. When worn, the entire shoe <u>including shoelaces</u> must be black. You must wear black crew socks with the uniform. Your shoes are your personal property and should be taken home with you after each use. If shoes are found in the uniform bags, a dry-cleaning fee may be assessed at the discretion of the Director and/or QNC.

Casual Uniform

The Band will wear the Casual Uniform at the Director's discretion. The Casual Uniform consists of the <u>current</u> Garnet Show Shirt, good quality solid color khaki pants/shorts, black crew socks and the regular uniform shoes.

GENERAL INFORMATION

Quarter Note Club Dues

All students who participate in ANY PART of the GVHS Band are required to pay QNC Dues. Annual Quarter Note Club dues are \$100 for the first student in a family, plus \$50 for each additional student in a family after the first. Dues are payable to the Quarter Note Club (QNC) and must be paid during the first week of Band Camp if you are in the marching band (by Friday August 16th, 2019). If you have sufficient funds in your student account, the money can be deducted from there. (Unfortunately, this will not apply to freshmen, as their middle school monies may not have yet transferred over to the High School account). Options for payment are detailed on the enclosed Dues Form, and include payment by cash or check as well as by credit card or bank card via the CHARMS website.

For anyone that may need financial assistance, please contact a member of the QNC Board.

The QNC dues are used for a variety of purposes to support the Band. During Band Camp, there are many special activities including band camp dinners, the end of year Band Banquet, pretzels during away games, hosting senior recognition night, dry cleaning fees at the end of the year,

hoodies for 3 year band members and small gifts at the end of the year for seniors. The QNC also sponsors two scholarships each year for graduating seniors.

Band Jackets

Student Account Information

Each student in the band has a personal student account that contains the money the student has raised through various fundraisers. The student can apply the money in their student account to pay for band dues, trips and activities.

It is important to note that the student account funds are allocated to each student for use in Band related activities only. The QNC cannot refund any unused cash back to students from their accounts. Left over money in Band accounts may pass to younger siblings – Notify the QNC Treasurer at the end of your older student's Senior Year. Other funds will revert to the QNC.
